Indian Institute of Finance Ranks 45 Among Top World Data Collectors

New Delhi, Feb 23 (UNI) The New Delhi-based Indian Institute of Finance (IIF) has been assigned the high ranking of 45th in the category of Finance for maintaining a sound data-base from among 141 organisations from all over the world by the American Statistical Association.

The Institute maintains financial data on different selected economic indicators, money and banking, international finance and international trade and industry to help researchers and policy makers.

IIF, which is also devoted to the task of imparting teaching, has also been ranked as 66th from among 255 organisations of all categories of databases (Microeconomics, Labour and Finance) by Business and Economic Data Links, a wing of the Association.
